- 1) We are aware that all packaging material for lumber products shipped by our Company to the United States must be Heat Treated (HT) or Kiln Dried (KD-HT) in an approved kiln facility, through approved kiln schedules to ensure that the core temperature of the lumber has reached 56°C for 30 minutes. We will also ensure that the identity of lumber is maintained.
- 2) We understand that under the ALS-WPM Program, we are permitted to grade stamp “HT” on the lumber that meets EU requirement of 56°C for 30 minutes. We also understand that the original grade stamps supplied are the property of CMSA.
- 3) We understand that Canadian Mill Services Association (CMSA) and/or CLS/ALS staff will be permitted access to perform audits on records related to Chain-of-Custody certification of HT.
- 4) We agree that should non-compliance be found during an audit or with the material prior to ship loading we will take immediate remedial action to ensure compliance.
- 5) We agree to indemnify and hold **Canadian Mill Services Association** and its members and employees harmless from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, and judgments including all costs, expenses and attorney fees which directly or indirectly may arise out of, or may be predicated upon, the company's issuance of such certificates as mentioned in 1) and 2) above, including the costs of any reinspection or corrective measures made necessary by shipments found not in compliance with the applicable certification requirements.
